Welcome back!

The start of the term is continuing on similar lines as the end of last term -

- Please do not send students who are unwell to school. If students are sick for 3 days they need to return with a medical certificate for absent days.
- Please drop students off and pick them up outside the school gates. Remember to social distance yourself while waiting. We are asking that staff and students are the ONLY people on the school grounds at this time. If you need to speak to your child's classroom teacher, please ring the front office and we will organise this for you.
- Middle School will not be on at this stage for the remainder of the year. 5/6 students will be having rotations on a Thursday and normal class routine on a Friday.

We will be following good hygiene practices such as:

- Regularly washing hands
- Extra cleaning of high-touch surfaces
- Avoiding sharing drinks or food
- Coughing or sneezing into elbows, or a tissue.

School attendance: - All students should be at school unless:

- They have a medical certificate, which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition.
- They are currently unwell. If your child is unwell, please do not send them to school. If they are unwell at school, you or your nominated emergency contact will need to collect them immediately. Please make sure your contact details are up to date.
- Students and staff with flu like symptoms will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school.






Touch Football
