## WEEK 7 LIBRARY NEWS:

**Why hasn't my child brought home their library book?**



Students need to bring their library bag to school to borrow a book to take home. A library bag protects our school library books from damage caused by food, drink and dirt.

If students in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 don't bring their library bags on the day of their library lesson they put the books they borrow in their classroom tray or in their classroom book box. These students need to continue to borrow and read books so they can complete the New South Wales Premier's Reading Challenge independently.

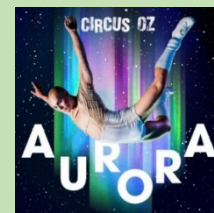

Teams play 2 games each fortnight on a Sunday in the Southern Inland Rugby Union competition commencing in Young on Sunday, 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2020.

Registration fees this year also include socks, shorts, hoodie jumper and sausage sandwiches after each training session. The costs are as follows:

- Under 6s (unisex non-tackle) - \$100
- Under 8s to Under 14s (unisex tackle\*) - \$130
- Girls Touch 7s - \$100

\*Girls who turn 13 and 14 years of age in 2020 can be dispensated to play U12s tackle.
