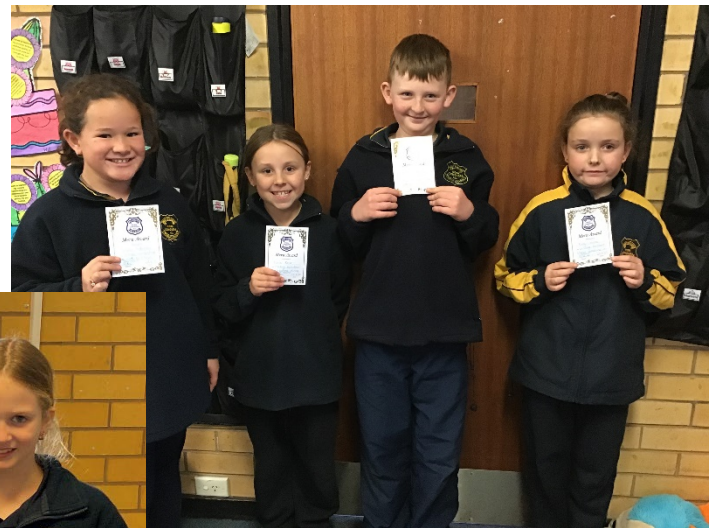

The date was Monday 18th March 2020 when Mrs Hopper took year 5/6 out on to the lawn and said 'Yes of tomorrow we will be starting Home Learning. I also can't wait for the June the 1st! It will be the best! (I wasn't out on Mrs Hopper lawn because)

3. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
4. Stay home if you are sick.
5. Cover your coughs and sneezes with your elbow or a tissue.
6. Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

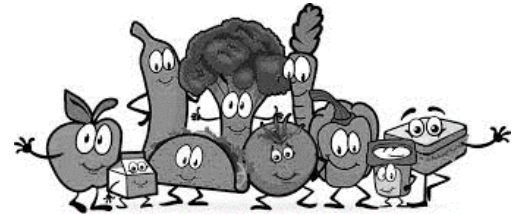

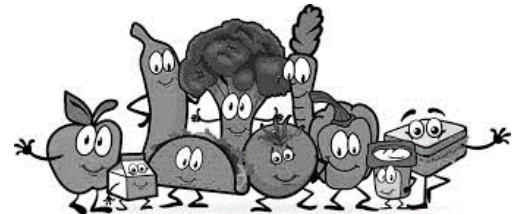
