## From the Principal's Desk

Welcome to Term 3!

I hope everyone had a restful break and are ready for a term of learning. Again we start the term with the unknown. With the new Covid-19 outbreaks both in Victoria and in parts of NSW like South West Sydney and the Batemans Bay areas, we ask you to think about where you have been in the last two weeks. If you have travelled to NSW affected areas and visited establishments where recent cases have also visited, please STAY AT HOME for 14 days isolation. If you have any symptoms of cold and flu, STAY AT HOME and get tested. If you visited Victoria please complete 14 days isolation guidelines from NSW Health.

The start of the term is continuing on similar lines as the end of last term -

- ✓ PLEASE make sure students bring a water bottle every day.
- ✓ Please do not send students who are unwell to school. If students are sick for 3 days they need to return with a medical certificate for absent days.
- ✓ Please drop students off and pick them up outside the school gates. Remember to social distance yourself while waiting. We are asking that staff and students are the ONLY people on the school grounds at this time. If you need to speak to your child's classroom teacher, please ring the front office and we will organise this for you.
- ✓ **Middle School** will resume this Thursday for our Year 5/6 students. Please make sure students bring a water bottle.

We will be following good hygiene practices such as:

- Regularly washing hands
- Extra cleaning of high-touch surfaces
- Avoiding sharing drinks or food
- Coughing or sneezing into elbows, or a tissue.

School attendance: - All students should be at school unless:

- They have a medical certificate, which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition.
- They are currently unwell. If your child is unwell, please do not send them to school. If they are unwell at school, you or your nominated emergency contact will need to collect them immediately. Please make sure your contact details are up to date.

In this Newsletter, we have attached our **Expression of Interest for 2021 Kindergarten** students. If you have a child who will be attending school next year please fill in the form and return to school ASAP. If you know of neighbours or friends with children who will be attending school, please pass on the expression of interest forms.
